"MY MERCY IS GREATER THEN MY JUSTICE" - JESUS

Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, now Saint Faustina, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with Him between 1934 and 1938. Jesus asked her to paint a picture depicting His merciful divinity (pictured right) being poured out from His Sacred heart and 14 times specifically asked her for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in Diary entry 699:

"My daughter, tell the whole world about my inconceivable mercy, I desire the Feast of Mercy to be a refuge and a shelter for all souls and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates are opened through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that

no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity.

Everything that exists has come from the very depths of my most tender mercy. Every soul in its relationship to me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from the depths of my tenderness. It is My desire that it be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the fount of My mercy.



The first Sunday after Easter is called "Divine Mercy Sunday"

In the painting of Jesus, Jesus Himself explained to St. Faustina that, "The two rays represent blood (in red on the left) and water (in white on the right)" (Diary 299) Remember the evangelist John, who, when a soldier on Calvary pierced Jesus's side with a spear, the soldier saw **blood and water** flowing from it. (John 19:34) The image of Jesus, the Divine Mercy, is to have a special place of honor on the Feast of Mercy, a visual reminder of all that Jesus did for us through His Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

OTHER WORDS OF JESUS TO ST.

FAUSTINA: *"Let all mankind recognize My unfathomable mercy, it is a sign for the end times; after it will come the day of justice. I want the image solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to*

be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it." (Diary 341)

The Feast of Mercy emerged from the very depths of my mercy... every soul believing and trusting in My mercy will obtain it. (Diary 420) *"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere."* (Diary 742)



In the Catholic faith:

To venerate does not mean to worship. Worship and praise are due only to God. We never adore or worship statues or pictures or paintings. We VENERATE THEM or show honor, reverential respect, feelings of love, respect honor for the person and their life depicted. Like a family photo.

As you read the Diary of Faustina Kowalska, you find this little prayer: *"You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls and the ocean of mercy opened for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us."* (Diary 1319)

Immediately after these words and without any further explanation St. Faustina records this unexpected request of Our Lord: *"At three o'clock, (each day), implore my mercy especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in my abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world... In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of my Passion."* (Diary 1320) About 4 months later, again, without any introduction, St. Faustina penned these words of our Lord: *"I remind you, My daughter, that as often as you hear the clock strike the third hour, immerse yourself completely in My mercy, adoring and glorifying it; invoke its omnipotence for the whole world, and particularly for poor sinners, for at that moment mercy was opened wide for every soul. In this hour you can obtain everything for yourself and for others for the asking; it was the hour of grace for the whole world- mercy triumphed over justice."*

A SPECIAL PROMISE OF MERCY: Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina, each time in a slightly different way:

"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy (1109) 2. Whoever approaches the Fount of Life (Eucharist) on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment. (300) 3. The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.

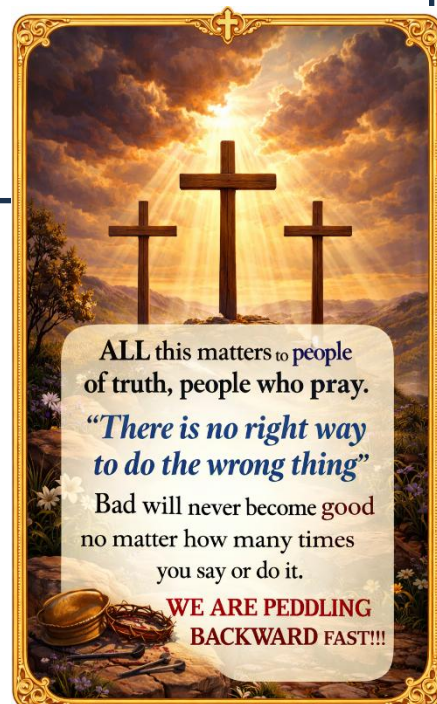
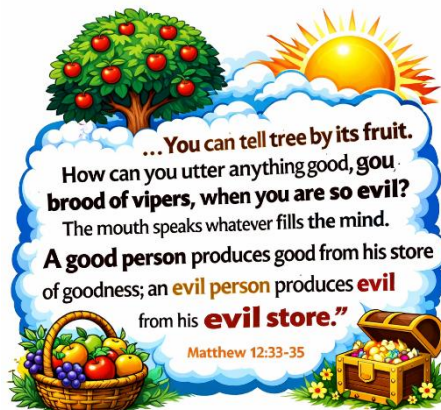

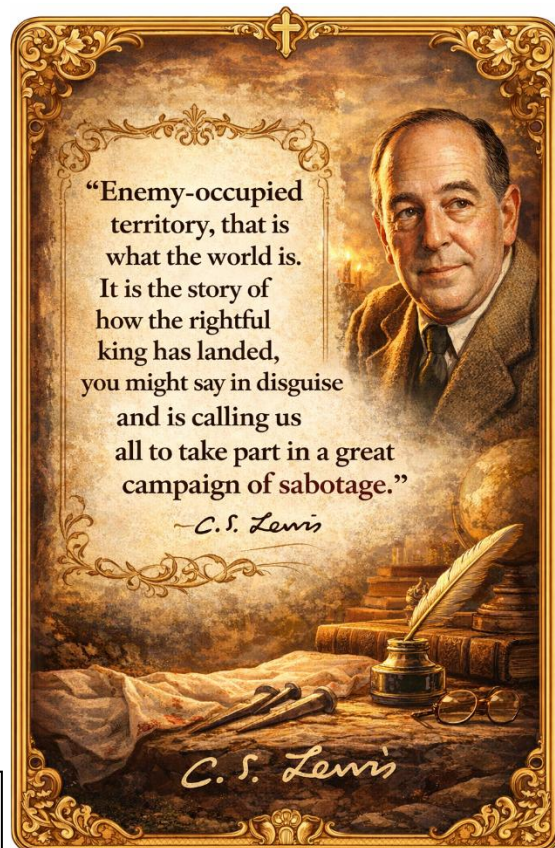
